HOLY COMMUNION IS...

A REMEMBRANCE of Christ's sacrificial death and glorious resurrection;
A CELEBRATION of God's covenant of forgiveness, love and hope;
A REMINDER of God's presence among us;
A RE-ENACTMENT of the Last Supper, the last meal Jesus had with
His disciples;
ONE OF THE TWO SACRAMENTS instituted by Christ (visible symbols of
God's love and grace acting in our lives, an outward sign of
Inward grace).

OPEN COMMUNION: WHO MAY PARTICIPATE?

All United Methodists should receive communion when given the opportunity.
All members of other Christian churches are welcome to participate, always.
All baptized Christians are welcome to participate (there is no age or
Membership requirement).
All persons who intend to lead a Christian life are invited to receive this
holy sacrament.

HOW DO WE RECEIVE HOLY COMMUNION?

- **Kneeling, standing, or sitting.**
- **At the front of the church, at our seats, at the communion rail, or at some specially established location.**
- **With a common loaf, a common cup; by intinction (receiving a piece of bread and then dipping it in the cup); individual pieces of bread and individual cups; or any combination of these.**
