For many years now, the youth ministry here at WUMC has been known as Crossroads. Effective January 10th, Crossroads Student Ministries will be known as SoulFire Student Ministries. The name comes from Jeremiah 20:9, which reads:

But if I say, "I will not mention him or speak any more in his name," his word is in my heart like a fire, a fire shut up in my bones. I am weary of holding it in; indeed, I cannot.

It is this verse which SoulFire Student Ministries will focus on and attempt to live out. Our soul should be so in tune with God that even in the darkest hour our heart cries out to the Father.
